

**Church of Scotland  
Stewartry of Strathearn SC030799  
Interim Reordering at Dunning Church Working Group  
Reporting to the Fabric Cluster.**

A meeting of the Working Group appointed to progress the Interim Reordering of the Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning, was held in Dunning Church Session House at 14.00 hours on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009.

**Present:** Group Convenor Raymond Young, Bill Peebles, Fiona Wemyss and Secretary Duncan M Dow.

**In attendance:** Electrician George Carstairs.

**1. Constitute Meeting:** The Convenor welcomed everyone to the meeting.

**2. Apologies:** Interim Moderator the Rev. Derek Lawson, Locum Minister the Rev. Ray Gaston and Alfred Marshall.

**3. Minutes of the previous meeting:** The Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2009 were approved and signed off.

**4. Matters arising:** The Convenor advised the Group members that as a result of a decision made at the previous meeting, the Secretary and himself, had visited Mr Allan Marshall Lighting Consultant, and explained the position regarding the work involved requiring to be signed off at the completion of work by a qualified person. As he was unable to meet this criterion, the Group indicated, that their preference was to employ Mr George Carstairs to carry out all electrical work as he was suitably qualified. Mr Marshall was offered the opportunity to continue as Lighting Consultant which he declined.

**5. Progress Report on all outstanding tasks:**

**Sanctuary**

1. Changes to the Chancel (including the installation of two floodlights, and the removal of the organ) were noted; a further light was to be added – suspended to allow access to roof space (to be completed in time for the Centenary celebrations).
2. It was agreed to refurbish the existing lights in the Sanctuary on a phased basis, starting in early October.
3. Electrician George Carstairs agreed to obtain further information regarding back lighting the stained glass windows. A further meeting with Mr George Paton from Ansell lighting was to be arranged.
4. The location of the Choir was to be experimented with, by removing two of the short pews beside the organ, and adjusting the carpet requirements as necessary.

## **Kitchen**

1. The kitchen units were to be replanned if necessary, once the size of the hot water cylinder was known.

## **Toilet**

1. The existing internal wall, will require to be removed after all, which will probably incur increased plumbing costs.
2. The Convenor agreed to approach a local architect in Dunning, for a drawing of the proposed changes.

**6. Date of the next meeting:** The date of the next meeting of the Group was arranged for Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2009 at 14.00 hours in Dunning Church Session House.

**A.O.C.B.** As there was no further business to discuss the Convenor thanked those in attendance and closed the meeting at 16.00 hours.
