Interim Reordering at Dunning Church Working Group
Reporting to the Fabric Cluster.**

A meeting of the Working Group appointed to progress the Interim Reordering of the Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning, was held in Dunning Church Session House at 19.30 hours on Wednesday 4th February 2009.

Present: Group Convenor Raymond Young, Alfred Marshall, Bill Peebles, Simon Rhodes, Fiona Wemyss and Group Secretary Duncan M Dow.

Apologies: Locum Minister The Rev. Elizabeth Brown and Catriona Harrison.

In attendance: Lighting Consultant Alan Marshall.

1. Constitute Meeting: The Convenor extended a warm welcome to all group members present, and thanked Lighting Consultant Mr Alan Marshall for attending.

2. Order of Business: The Convenor indicated a change to the order of business, as Mr Alan Marshall had kindly come to the meeting to give the group further advice on the improved lighting in Dunning Church. After a short discussion and demonstration Mr Marshall was instructed to purchase either 1 or 2 of the agreed lights for demonstration purposes. He agreed to do this, and report back to the next group meeting with approximate costs if possible.

3. Minutes of the previous Meeting: The Minutes from the meeting held on Wednesday 7th January 2009 were approved and signed off.

4. Matters arising:

a) Pulpit falls: Mr Alfred Marshall reported to the meeting, that he had received the new Pulpit Falls, and allowed the group members to view them. Everyone agreed that they were satisfactory. The Secretary was instructed to make arrangements with Locum Minister, The Rev. Elizabeth Brown to dedicate the new Pulpit Falls during the Service on Sunday 15th February 2009.

b) Church Reordering:

- Mr Alfred Marshall produced a selection of carpet samples with prices he had obtained with a view to re-carpeting Dunning Church in time for the Centenary Celebrations. It was agreed that Mr Marshall should proceed to get prices
- Kitchen – meeting arranged for Mrs Fiona Wemyss and others to measure kitchen and select fittings
- Disabled toilet – measurements still to be taken
- Cupboards in hall – agreed to design cupboards in such away as to allow North facing window to continue to provide light, with storage and seating underneath
