### **Reordering of Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning**

A meeting of the Steering Group appointed to progress the Reordering of Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning was held in Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning at 1930 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

Present Rev. Colin R Williamson, Katrina Bell, Raymond Young, Alfred Marshall and Duncan M Dow Clerk to the Congregational Board.

The meeting opened with a discussion on the observations, from the recent tour of other local Churches that had undergone reordering.

This helped to focus the aims and standards the group hoped to achieve in respect of Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning. All the members agreed that it had been a very worthwhile and informative exercise of what lay ahead.

Amongst many points arising from this discussion, Colin agreed to contact Kinross Church and explore the possibility of the Project Manager in charge at Kinross, making a visit to Dunning at a future Steering Group meeting and passing on any helpful advice gained during their project. Raymond also agreed to contact architect David Murdoch, who had been instrumental in advising the Kinross group. Katrina agreed to contact Sarah Webb a parishioner who has recently qualified as an architect with very good references. It was hoped that Sarah would be interested in assisting in the architectural points, and giving her thoughts on any points arising in this respect for our project.

The Group also agreed to approach Catriona Harrison, and ask her to take on the responsibility, in keeping the Congregation involved and aware of the progress throughout the project.

The Group are very aware that not only the Congregation of Stewartry of Strathearn at Dunning, but all four Churches within the Stewartry have to be kept informed of the aims and progress of the project at all times.

It was hoped that this could be achieved through the Stewartry Banner every quarter, and through the Church website, which would be updated on a regular basis, and that an additional Bulletin could be circulated throughout the Stewartry as and when necessary.

It was hoped that by the Summer of 2008 we would be in a position to obtain the Board's recommendation who we wish to work along with in order to progress this project.

Several points within the Architect's brief were updated and clarified.

The date of the next Group meeting was arranged for Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2008 in the Church Office at Aberdalgie in order to gain access to the original plans.
